JURY TRIAL

On [REDACTED] [REDACTED] the Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] the Defendant, and Manuel Leiva, Counsel for the Defendant, appeared before this Court. The Defendant is indicted for the felony of ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER (Count I) and the misdemeanor of OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE (Count II) and she appeared while on bond.

Emeli Cox, an interpreter who is fluent in the Spanish language, was sworn to interpret on behalf of the Defendant.

The roll call was taken and the Jurors took their place in the Jury Room and they continued their deliberations.

After some time, the Jury returned to Court and rendered the following verdict:

"We, the Jury, on the issue joined in the case of the Commonwealth of Virginia versus [REDACTED] Defendant, find the Defendant as to Count I, not guilty and as to Count II, guilty of OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE.
